LUNCH PASS RULES 2015/2016

Form 6

The right to leave the school grounds at lunch-time is restricted to students in **Form 6**. This pass is exclusively for the purpose of taking lunch in a restaurant/café in Ranelagh Village. In the case of takeaway lunches they must be brought back to the school and eaten on the premises.

Forms 1 - 5

Students in other forms who live close to the school and whose parents have requested that they return home for lunch may do so but must not purchase lunch in Ranelagh.

Rules for all Lunch Pass holders

A student who is issued with a lunch pass must have it on his/her person at all times and show it on request to a member of staff or to a duty prefect.

Students must be back on the school premises at 12.55 p.m. or 13.35 p.m. (depending on their lunch period) to begin class. Students who are late risk losing their lunch pass.

Parents who apply for and who consent to the issue of a lunch pass should be aware that students leaving the school for lunch are <u>not</u> under the supervision of the school staff.

A lunch pass will be withdrawn if a student is found to be in breach of school rules whilst in Ranelagh during the lunch break.

General Rules

Students in Forms 1-5, who are not taking school lunch, should bring a packed lunch from home as they will not be allowed to leave the grounds to purchase items for a packed lunch in the local shops.

In the *most exceptional circumstances* permission to leave may only be granted by the Principal or the Deputy Principal.
